Notes

* The occupancy rating provides a measure of under-occupancy and overcrowding. For example a value of -1 implies that there is one room too few and that there is overcrowding in the household. The occupancy rating assumes that every household, including one person households, requires a minimum of two common rooms (excluding bathrooms).

The room requirement is calculated as follows:

- a one person household is assumed to require three rooms (two common rooms and a bedroom)
- where there are two or more residents it is assumed that they require a minimum of two common rooms plus one bedroom for:
 - each couple (as determined by the relationship question)
 - each lone parent
 - any other person aged 16 or over
 - each pair aged 10 to 15 of the same sex
 - · each pair of children aged under 10 remaining
 - each remaining person (either aged 10 to 15 or under 10).

Note

*A household's accommodation is described as 'with central heating' if it had central heating in some or all rooms (whether used or not). Central heating included gas, oil or solid fuel central heating, night storage heaters, warm air heating and underfloor heating. The information is not available for unoccupied household spaces.

**A household's accommodation is described as having sole use of bath/shower and toilet if it had a bath/shower and a toilet for use only by that household. 'Without sole use' means that the household had to share, or did not have, one or both amenities. The information is not available for unoccupied household spaces.
